Who We Are

Tampa Downtown Partnership is a private, not-for-profit 501(c)(6) organization. It is a membership organization comprised of companies, organizations, and individuals with a common goal of advancing Downtown Tampa. Through an annual contract with the City of Tampa, the Tampa Downtown Partnership administers the Special Services District.

About the Special Services District

The Special Services District (SSD) is the longest operating Business Improvement District in the State of Florida. It encompasses 1,192 acres. Funding for the SSD comes from an assessment placed on non-exempt property owners within the district. This assessment is \$1.0285 per \$1,000 in assessed value from the Hillsborough County Property Appraiser's office. In FY20-21, the SSD budget was \$3,284,930.

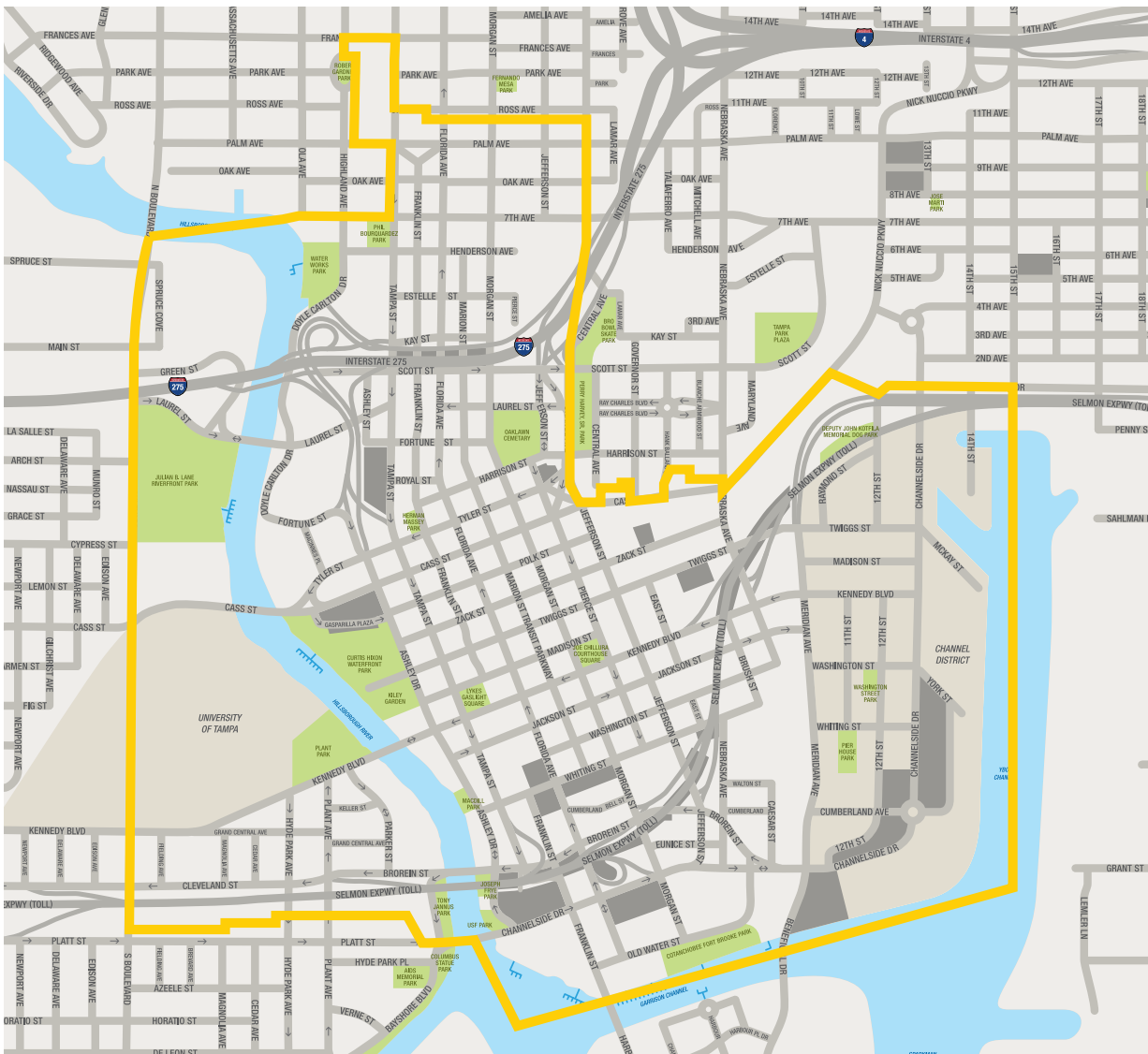

Formed in 1994, the clean and safe programs were developed to provide supplemental services to public areas located within the Downtown Special Services District. The mission is simple... provide a cleaner, safer, and more friendly environment for workers, residents, and visitors to the area.

TAMPA’S DOWNTOWN GUIDES

The Guides provide a safe and inviting Downtown environment through their role as on-street ambassadors. They help deter suspicious activity as Downtown’s additional eyes and ears, and offer a friendly concierge- type service. The Downtown Guides are unarmed public safety ambassadors, First Aid Certified, and work closely with the Tampa Police Department through the Downtown Security Network. They patrol the Special Services District (SSD) on foot, bicycle, and in service vehicles.

COMMUNITY OUTREACH

The Partnership’s Homeless Liaison works daily with individuals experiencing homelessness and others in need, connecting them with available resources. These resources include short and long-term housing options, transportation, employment assistance, and medical care.

TAMPA’S DOWNTOWN CLEAN TEAM

The Clean Team provides supplemental litter and debris removal, minor landscaping, and maintenance to the sidewalks, curbs, and other public areas located within the District, to maintain a clean and safe experience. Team members also observe and report code enforcement issues, trip hazards, street light outages, and other relevant concerns related to the look and safety of Downtown.

BEAUTIFICATION Enhancement initiatives improve the aesthetics of Downtown’s streetscape through such programs as potted plant installation and special trash collection.

SPECIAL EVENT ASSISTANCE Tampa’s Downtown Clean Team and Tampa’s Downtown Guides are available for hire to meet and greet event goers, hand out valuable literature, give directions, and provide maintenance at special events.

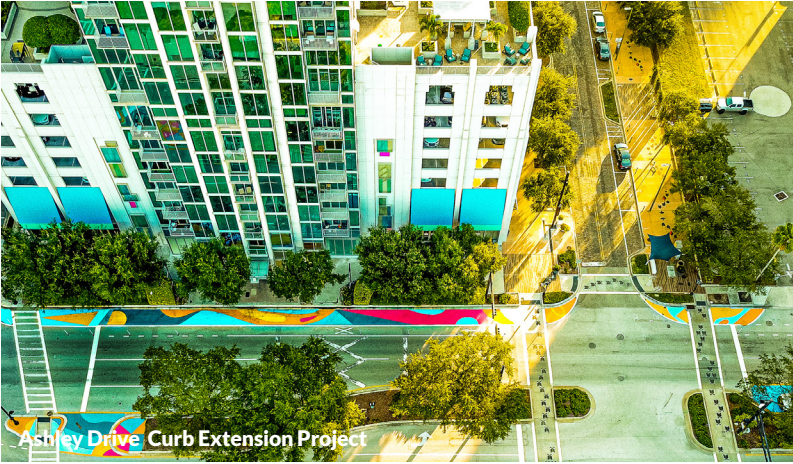
Placemaking & Public Space Development

Tampa Downtown Partnership’s Placemaking initiatives advance our public spaces into highly programmed and attractive places. Placemaking is a multifaceted approach to the planning, design, and management of public spaces. Recurring initiatives include events such as Rock the Park, free fitness classes, River O’Green Fest, Winter Village, and Boom by the Bay. Small business stimulus programs such as the Downtown Dollar and the storefront and sidewalk grant are offered to ground floor business and property owners to promote and enhance Tampa’s Downtown merchants.

Transportation & Planning

The Partnership’s Transportation Management Organization looks for ways to improve Downtown mobility, commuting, and parking options. The goal is to provide maximum accessibility and mobility to and within the urban core by offering multiple options that are affordable, convenient, and sustainable.
